 - > Available at all grade levels
 - > College level course
 - > Shows on high school transcript only
 - > How do you earn college credit?
- Dual Enrollment courses
 - > Available to qualified 11th & 12th grade students
 - > Shows on high school and college transcript
 - > Eligibility criteria
 - > Full time options: Early College and Early Admissions
- Honors courses
 - > Available at all grade levels
 - > Shows on high school transcript
 - > Does not earn college credit

Course Type Comparison

Course Type	Course Weight	College Level Course Expectations	College Credit
AP	+1.0	Yes	Yes, based on AP Exam score – on high school transcript only
Dual Enrollment	+1.0	Yes	Yes, based on final grade of C or higher – on high school & college transcript
Honors	+1.0 for current 9 th grade +0.5 for incoming 9 th grade	No, college preparatory, but not college level	No
