

SAC Meeting Minutes- ELMS Performing Arts Building

1. Call to Order

2. Approval of Minutes

3. Presentations: Year-to-Date Data Overview: Looking at the data to determine what tweaking needs to take place

Review of SIP Goals: ELA from 85% to 89% Math 91% to 96%, Science from 83% to 86%, Civics – to maintain 100%; Engineering increase from 89% to 100%, 7th grade to pass the Design Process test from 88% to 90%, the amount of 6th grade to pass the Design Process test and remain above 80%; College and Career Readiness to increase from 92% to 93%

ELA Write Score: Cycle 2 testing data: Write Score Reading Data: Data was received, showed a slight decrease, but this seems to have happened across the district. Write Score provides a large variety of lesson that all teachers will be working with to support the Reading strategies across the curriculum. SRI Testing: Data to come later. Write Score Writing data showed a small increase in achievement across the grade levels. Teachers will continue to target areas of need to help students improve.

Math: Math 6th Adv and Regular had the top scores in the district for both cycle tests. Algebra 1 increased 9% points; Math 7 Adv increased 15%; 85% all math scores were above the district average. Comparing to the district there were benchmarks that students across the district did not achieve. Math teachers are looking at the pockets of students that did not achieve on certain specific standards for remediation.

Civics and Science: Civics and Science 2 Acc Honors highest scores both cycle tests; Physical Science highest scores in cycle 1, Science 1 increased 9% points; 84 % scored above all district average.

STEM – data will not come until final. All students completed the Young Inventors Challenge.

PSAT 8th grade test: 2018 score average was 960, 158 points above the District average, and 48 points above the 2017 school average.

4. New Business: SAC Member moved in December. We have an opening on the committee and need to fill the spot. Amira Ray nominated Shannon Kennedy to fill the role. All in favor, none opposed.

Discussing of aligning Middle School to High school times for safety, security, and resource benefits. District is looking at moving High School start time again. There will be a Town Hall meeting on January 22, 2019 to have discussion regarding concerns and input.
