6. Open Discussion: FSA vs Best – FSA is the end of the year test aligned to our standards as of now. ELA and MATH standards are the ones that are changing (current standards are LASF). The district is implementing training over the summer for the new BEST standards. It is not a lot of big changes, mostly it is how they are splitting up the categories within the standards to streamline teaching. They are cutting out the not-so-necessary things. Updated as of February, but full implementation for ELA is in Fall of 2021. For Math they are clearly organizing and chunking the standards to give the students a better understanding of what is expected. Started with Algebra, cross walk during the February in-service training, the more in depth training this summer. Full implementation for new math standards in 2022-2023.
