High School Credit/GradPoint FAQ

What is GradPoint?


GradPoint is a credit recovery program which allows students, whether currently in high school or adults without a diploma, to make up high school credits online. This can be accomplished in our lab on the Clearwater Adult Education Center campus or on a home computer with an internet connection. All testing must be completed in the school lab.

What is the admission and registration process?

Current high school students wishing to enroll in GradPoint should speak to their guidance counselor who will issue them the necessary paperwork (PCS Form 2097). Students should then bring their PCS Form 2097 to the Clearwater Adult Education Center office where they will be enrolled in GradPoint and can begin classes. Tuition does not apply to co-enrolled high school students.

Adult students (not currently enrolled in a Pinellas County school) should come to the Clearwater Adult Education Center office with their transcripts if available. Tuition fees apply.

Summer Hours (June 5 - July 13) 11:00 A.M. - 6:00 P.M., Monday through Thursday.



What are daytime ESOL students learning in June?

- Level 0-2 Teacher Nada's class will be talking about health.
- Level 3 Teacher Yllka's class will study food, greetings, household chores, and free-time activities.
- **Level 4** Students will learn about furniture and appliances and how to compare them in terms of size, price and quality.
- **Level 5** Students will study the present perfect tense to talk about work experiences in interviews. After that, they'll use the past progressive tense to discuss crimes and emergencies.
- **Level 6** Students will do listening, reading, writing and speaking activities <u>focused on the topics of daily living</u> and free time.
- Level 7 Students will continue working with Burlington English CASAS PREP.

ABE/GED FAQ

Do I need to test first?

Yes, all students must test <u>before</u> enrolling in a class. Photo ID is required. TABE testing is offered every Monday through Thursday at 8:00 A.M. and again at 5:00 P.M.

When do classes meet?

ABE/GED classes are 8:00 A.M. till 8:30 P.M., Monday through Thursday, for June and July. The Arcturas Annex will be closed on Fridays beginning on Friday, June 9th, until the end of the summer term, which is July 13th.

Is there a fee?

Yes, tuition is due at time of testing. The \$30.00 fee includes tuition for the current term. We accept cash, checks, and money orders.




