- Virtual School – Many students are taking virtual courses to meet their online requirement and also because they selected the courses. It is imperative that students keep up with the coursework so they are not withdrawn from the virtual course. All coursework has to align with the number of release periods.
- College Applications – Many schools have already opened their college application period. It is important that students check the websites for the schools they are looking at on a regular basis for updates and deadlines.
 - Students are allowed **3 college visits** in their senior year. Those visits must be requested ahead of the visit and documentation from the school must be provided upon return. Students can obtain the request form in the office (Student Services) or on the guidance website under the “Seminar Presentations & Resources” section. The in-school SAT will be proctored to seniors that registered, free of charge, on September 23rd. ***If your student did not opt-in and pay for the SAT (registration is closed), this would be a great day to schedule a college visit.***
 - If your student has questions about applying to college, please be sure they see their guidance counselor quickly so as not to miss important deadlines.
- Attendance and Grades – It is important to check FOCUS and Canvas regularly. Student attendance and grades are monitored by the administration. Any student that is noted to have multiple absences or failing grades will be monitored and conferences will be scheduled to ensure that students stay on track to graduate. If you have any specific concerns regarding your senior, please be sure to contact your student’s administrator or counselor.

 - Reminder, that consistent with School Board Policies, students may exempt a course for which they have an A or B both marking periods (2nd marking period being anticipated). Attendance is not a factor for exam exemptions for Semester 1 of the 2020-21 school year. First semester they can exempt **up to three**.

 - If/when students are ready to begin applying and sending transcripts to colleges, MUST get request card from Ms. Valdes’ in Guidance signed for records release.
 - Official transcripts are \$2 each, unofficial copies are \$1, and if the school accepts FASTER or SPEEDE transfer, they can be sent for free electronically
